Grades 9 / 10 equivalence	<u>y credits</u>
✓English or Français =	up to 4 credits
✓Math =	up to 4 credits
✓ Sciences =	up to 4 credits
✓Geography / History =	up to 4 credits

The Student:

- was born in February 1986 (22 years old)
- started at 14 years of age in September 2000 at a regular secondary school
- has completed three (3) grade 9/10 credits
- all 3 credits are compulsory;
- must complete the following assessments for a total of 13 equivalency credits (11 compulsory credits):

English (or Français if student is in a French High School) Math Science

Geography / History

Potential Equivalency Credit Distribution

- Scenario 1:
 - English or Français = 4 credits
 - Math = 4 credits
 - Science = 3 credits
 - Geography / History = 2 credits
- Scenario 2:






