## Why hasn't OSSTF/FEESO modified its position?

### We are standing up for publicly-funded education.

#### In 2019, the Ford government increased average class size to 22.5 resulting in:

- · fewer courses available to students
- limited pathway opportunities
- · fewer teachers and education workers in schools

#### In 2020, Ford and Lecce plan to:

- increase average class size to 28 (although they have offered 25)
- make 2 e-Learning courses mandatory with average class sizes of 35

#### These changes will mean that students will have:

- EVEN fewer courses
- · EVEN less funding for resources and supports
- EVEN fewer teachers/education workers

# OSSTF/FEESO believes that these changes damage publicly-funded education and hurt students.

#### We stand by our position:

- return to 2018–2019 class size averages of 22
- keep e-Learning voluntary for students
- ensure appropriate number of teachers and education workers to meet student needs
