- A budget of estimated research expenses.

Theme Identified for the 2025-2026 Academic Year:

• Building Stronger Schools and Universities: Advancing Democratic Governance Through Meaningful Community Participation (Preference will be given to applications with an Ontario and/or Canadian Education focus).

Note: At least one of the three (3) grants will be reserved for researchers who identify as Indigenous, equity-seeking, or oppressed groups.

The application deadline for the 2025-2026 Academic year is **by 4:00 p.m. on January 31, 2026**. All successful applicants will be informed by February 16, 2026.
