ONTARIO K-12 TEACHERS' EXPERIENCES OF SEXUAL HARASSMENT BY STUDENTS

ABOUT THE PROJECT

The purpose of this research is to interview Ontario K-12 teachers who have experienced unwanted sexual attention or behaviour by students.

YOU CAN PARTICIPATE IF

- You are a current or former Ontario K-12 teacher;
- You have experienced student behaviour that made you feel uncomfortable, crossed boundaries, or undermined your authority;
- The behaviour targeted you based on your sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, or gender expression;
- The behaviour was demeaning, offensive, or abusive;
- You wished for the behaviour to stop;
- The behaviour was shocking or vulgar.
- Your experience is not part of an active legal investigation, grievance, or court process

If you meet the criteria above and would like to share your story in a confidential research interview, you are invited to participate.

WHAT IS INVOLVED?

- A one-time 60-90 minute interview on Zoom, where you can share your experience and possible institutional response
- You will have the option to review the transcript and suggest changes
