### LDAC-ACTA Virtual Conference (November 22, 2025)

The Learning Disabilities Association of Canada - Association canadienne des troubles d'apprentissage (LDAC-ACTA) <a href="www.ldac-acta.ca">www.ldac-acta.ca</a> is holding a virtual conference from 11:00 a.m. to 4:45 p.m. on November 22, 2025. OSSTF/FEESO has reserved a block of up to 50 tickets for OSSTF/FEESO members to attend. All conference sessions will only be in English.

The Learning Disabilities Association of Canada (LDAC) is Canada's network of learning disabilities associations from all Canadian provinces and territories. Their work is on promoting and disseminating research, many from Canadian researchers, and best practices in understanding learning disabilities (LDs) which culminates this year with their national virtual conference on November 22, 2025.

#### **About the Conference**

The goal of the LDAC-ACTA virtual conference is to get the latest research and best practices from across Canada in the hands of those that need it, including OSSTF/FEESO members. This years' conference was expanded to include aspects where Attention Deficit and Hyperactivity (ADH) intersect with learning disabilities.

Recordings of all sessions (keynote address and all workshops) will be available to registrants for 30 days after the end of the conference.

LDCA-ACTA will provide attendees, upon request after the conference, a certificate of attendance which some professional colleges may recognize as fulfilling a portion of a college member's annual professional development requirements.

### **Registration Process**

Members are to complete **Attachment 2** and send their request form to Loredana Merenda (<u>loredana.merenda@osstf.ca</u>) and copying Marc Robillard (<u>marc.robillard@osstf.ca</u>) no later than 4:00 p.m. on November 18, 2025.

Each District will be allocated one (1) initial ticket, for up to 37 of the reserved 50 tickets.

Remaining tickets, will be allocated according to the order in which the request forms were received but, to ensure that Districts with both teacher and education worker members each have an opportunity to attend the conference, then the next ticket to the District will be allocated to the member who is in a different Bargaining Unit than the first recipient from that District.

The list of approved registrants from OSSTF/FEESO will be sent to the LDAC-ACTA by noon on November 19, 2025. Provincial Office will also communicate with the members that were approved as registrants to the conference.

LDAC-ACTA will register each member. The approved members will receive an invitation for the conference from LDAC-ACTA that will contain the link to the event. To ensure that you receive the invitation, you will be asked to provide your preferred email address and a second one on the OSSTF/FEESO request form in case you require assistance. This has been requested by LDAC-ACTA to facilitate the later registration process and potential needed tech support to access the conference.
