

Revised Provincial Office District/Bargaining Unit (D/BU) Memo Distribution Process

We are thrilled to announce the official launch of the new District/Bargaining Unit (D/BU) Memo distribution system on **Wednesday**, **November 5**, **2025**.

This new process will make it easier for Presidents and members to stay informed and connected to important Federation updates.

What's New

Weekly D/BU Memo Digest: Every Wednesday, a weekly *D/BU Memo Digest* will be issued to Presidents with a summary of all memos released that week. All-member D/BU Memos and President Memos will be separated in two sections in the email for easy forwarding to the right recipients of the information.

If information is urgent or time-sensitive, a Special Edition D/BU Memo Digest will be issued outside of the regular Wednesday schedule to ensure timely communication.

Accessing D/BU Memos: D/BU memos can be accessed in two ways,

1. Position targeted D/BU memos (i.e., Presidents Only, Presidents and Local Executives, Presidents and Chief Negotiators, etc.) and their corresponding attachments are hosted directly on the Provincial website, organized in an easy-to-navigate, accordion-style layout by month. This structure allows for quicker access to information without scrolling through lengthy archives.

How to Access D/BU Memos

- 1. Visit www.osstf.on.ca
- 2. Click the myOSSTF login button and sign in using your member ID and password.
- 3. Once signed in, navigate to the D/BU Memos section to view the latest updates or click on the direct link(s) provided in the weekly *D/BU Memo Digest*.

We have extended the myOSSTF sign-in timeout to **2 hours**. This enhancement allows you to remain logged in longer, reducing interruptions when accessing secure memos on the provincial website.
