The Provincial Executive is seeking to fill two vacancies on the OMERS Advisory Work Group. The vacancies are for three-year terms.

Regulation 12.6.8.1 states that:

The Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement System Advisory Work Group shall advise the Provincial Executive on any matters related to the Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement System and such other matters as may be referred to it by the Provincial Executive. (A.16)

The OMERS Advisory Work Group consists of representatives from Bargaining Units representing Education Workers who are members of OMERS. The work group meets at the request of the Provincial Executive whenever advice is needed on matters relating to OMERS. There is no set number of meetings in a year. The Provincial Office covers all costs associated with attending meetings, including time release from work and other expenses. Applicants will need to verify that they are able to secure time release through their Bargaining Unit by contacting their local president.

Any Education Worker who is a member in good standing with OSSTF/FEESO and is interested in applying for the OMERS Advisory Work Group must complete the form (Attachment 1) and submit it to Thomas Golightly, Executive Assistant at OSSTF/FESSO Provincial Office, by no later than **4:00 pm on Friday, September 26, 2025**.

Applicants are encouraged to complete the attached voluntary self-identification form (Attachment 2) and submit it with the application. The storage and use of this self-identification data will not be tied to any identifying information.
